#### 6. CEO UPDATE

Mr. Johnson reported that there will be a full Medicaid ISF and full Medicaid Savings carried over into FY2022, and there will be a lapse back to the state although we are unsure of the exact amount at this time.

The block grant funding has had issues with not having enough funding, but there have been three supplements issued with different rules than the traditional block grant. We are starting to work on proposals to use these funds.

There may be a third system redesign proposal likely coming out this Fall from House Democrats, in addition to the Whiteford and Shirkey proposals that have been introduced but not voted on. MDHHS has remained silent on all redesign efforts and is not taking a formal position at this time.

Mr. Johnson reported on the resettlement of Afghan nationals to the state of Michigan. It is anticipated that approximately 1,700 Afghan nationals will be relocated to four communities in Michigan. The city of Flint has been named as a fifth community to receive Afghan nationals in the state.

## 7. <u>BUDGET</u>

A. Monthly Financial Report - August 2021

Mr. Johnson presented the August 2021 report. Nothing significant to report at this time. The revenues are high due to increased Medicaid rolls and that will continue at least through the end of June 2022. We expect the revenue to be back to a more traditional level next year.
